*Please think of this as an academic, scholarly writing assignment. Both today and tomorrow, you will be asked to share your thoughts an opinions. Tonight you will support those opinions with reliable sources. Never reference a source by saying, "the guy in the article" or "the webpage author"... instead, find the name of the person or organization and refer to them by name, or say, "In today's class discussion..." For your first long entry you will then link your source(s) at the end of the post.

- Your posts are going into a public (to us) forum, therefore you need to follow the rules of grammar, sentence structure, spelling, and etiquette necessary when communicating through written language. Please use complete sentences. Check your spelling, and mind your manners.
- You will respond to an initial question or set of questions, and then you also have to respond to AT LEAST TWO other people.
- You must cite at least two sources to support what you are saying in your initial post. Please no repeats from classmates.
- Your responses to your peers do not require citation since they will be mostly your own thoughts, however, if you DO mention something that is not your own opinion and not common knowledge, you must cite the source of that info. If ever in doubt, cite it. If still in doubt, FIND A SOURCE to support what you're saying and cite *that*.
- These are graded, which means you really have to think deeply and provide *several* references for what you say. Please see attached rubric.
